5 ENTRIES:

Entry Form:

All Competitors must use Motorsport Online App to complete the Entry Form for their Category. The Event Organisers reserve the right to refuse any Entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

Entry Fee refunds policy will be at the discretion of the Organisers

By completing the Entry Form, Competitors (Drivers and Entrants) are deemed to fully understand the Motor Sport New Zealand National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules.

Entry Fee Refunds Policy

The Organisers advise that entry fee will only be refunded in full or in part under the following conditions:

- Non-acceptance of entry
- Cancellation of the meeting prior to commencement of documentation
- Withdrawal in writing prior to close of normal entries
- Withdrawal after normal entry closing but before the start time listed for qualifying for their class

The organisers confirm the entry fees will not be refunded for the following:

- Withdrawals or failure of a competitor to advise of non-appearance at the meeting after the commencement of Qualifying
- Abandonment or Cancellation of the meeting after the commencement of Documentation

Opening and Closing Dates:

Normal entries open at the publishing of these Supplementary Regulations on Friday 19th September 2025 and close on Wednesday 22nd October.

Entry Fees:

Class Coordinators will advise competitors their entry fees and payment requirements according to the grid fee charged to each class by the Event Organising Committee.

Note: The appropriate MSNZ Participation Levy shall be paid by competitors at entry on Motorsport
Online

Late Entry Fee: Entries received after the normal entries closing date will be charged a \$50 late fee

6 COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS & UNDERSTANDING:

License Requirements:

Unless otherwise stated in the individual Championship or Accredited Series Articles, each Driver must hold as a minimum a Motorsport New Zealand National C1 Grade Competition License

Entrants:

If the Entrant is other than a Driver, a Motorsport New Zealand Entrants License in the name of the Entrant is required. This is separate to a Motorsport New Zealand Competition License.

New Drivers:

Any Driver(s) who are racing at one of their first three(3) race events, or who have not previously competed at the circuit, or have not raced for two years or more must indicate this in their entry and attend the New Drivers Briefing session.

The New Drivers Briefing will be held in the Race Control Room on Level 2 of the control tower at 8:30am on Saturday 25th October

Written Drivers Briefing:

A written Drivers Briefing will be made available to all Competitors prior to the Event. The written Drivers Briefing holds the same authority as these Supplementary Regulations Part One and Part Two.

<u>Category Specific Drivers Briefings</u> may be held on Friday 23rd October. The time and location will be detailed in the Supplementary Regulations Part 2.

7 DOCUMENTATION & SAFETY AUDIT INSPECTION:

Documentation:

Documentation will take place in the Secretary's Office located to the right of the Assembly Area. All Competitors must complete Documentation prior to qualifying or racing. Competitors are reminded that 2025 OctoberFAST Supplementary Regulations Part One (V2)

they need to bring their current Competition License, MotorSport New Zealand Member Club Membership Card and Vehicle Logbook or electronic equivalent via Motorsport Online smartphone app to the Event. At the completion of documentation, competitors not requiring a vehicle audit will be issued with an "OK sticker" which must be attached at the top right of the windscreen before joining the circuit.

Safety Audit Inspections:

The Scrutineering Shed is midway along the Assembly Area. Those requiring full audits need to present their vehicles and safety apparel to the Scrutineers for inspection. At the completion of scrutineering, competitors will be issued with an "OK sticker" which must be attached at the top right of the windscreen before joining the circuit.

Scrutineering times will be published in Part Two of these Regulations

Remote Audits are authorized for this meeting. Competitors are encouraged to use remote scrutineering where possible to avoid delays at the event.

Remote scrutineering will be available (14) fourteen days out from the start each event starting on Friday 10th October 2025.

8 ACCESS TO VENUE.

- (1) Access to the venue is via Rata Street and South Street

- (3) Gates will be opened at 7am on Friday, Saturday and Sunday
- (4) All access lanes in and around the pits must be kept clear at all times during the Event
- (5) Gates will be closed at 7pm on Friday and Saturday
- (6) Competitors, including their associated people, are permitted to camp overnight in the Paddock on Friday and/or Saturday. 10 MEETING RIDES

2025 OctoberFAST Supplementary Regulations Part One (V2)

Meeting rides will take place, at the sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course, for 30 minutes only on Friday afternoon solely for the NZ Super Trucks and for 30 minutes only on Saturday afternoon for all other classes at the conclusion of the day's events. Meeting Rides will be run according to the Motorsport NZ Meeting Rides Policy. The document in full detail can be found in Competitor Resources: Race. All participants must comply with the requirements of this Policy or risk being penalised in accordance with the National Sporting Code.

- Drivers must be entered to compete in OctoberFAST. They must notify the Secretary of their intention to participate in Meeting Rides at documentation. No new driver entered in their first three meetings is eligible.
- Drivers may only drive the competition vehicle they have entered at the meeting. The passenger seat
 and harness and protective clothing must be safety audited and passed. Protective clothing for the
 passenger must comply with Schedule A Part One Article 4 Clubsport Advanced as a minimum.
- Passengers must complete and sign the Meeting Rides indemnity in the Secretary's Office by 3pm on Saturday prior to participation.
- Minimum age of passenger is twelve years.
- One meeting ride per person. No fellow competitor or any competition crew member is eligible to participate as a passenger.
- Passengers must be briefed by the team regarding safety procedures and 'panic word'. The team must ensure that all passengers are wearing their safety apparel and harness correctly prior to release.
- A meeting ride consists of exit the Pit Lane and continue the lap until the vehicle crosses the Start/Finish line, then complete that part of a further lap required to return to Pit Lane.
 The vehicle must NOT be driven at full racing speed. Circuit limits must be observed.

12 GENERAL INFORMATION:

Circuit Light Signals:

The Circuit's Approved Signal Light System shall be used for these events. Flags may be substituted at any time on instruction by the Clerk of the Course.

Fuel Handling and Storage:

Competitors are reminded to ensure that they are familiar with and abide by the MotorSport New Zealand Code of Practice – Fuel Handling and Storage. This can be found on the MotorSport New Zealand website at Competitor Resources. There is no Fuel available at the Circuit.

Waste Oil:

The Bulk Waste Oil Dump is located inside the Scrutineering Shed.

Used Tyres and Car Parts:

These must be removed from the venue at the conclusion of the event

Pit Bikes and Quad Bikes:

May only be operated by licenced drivers wearing approved helmets

Dogs in the Paddock

Service dogs ONLY in the Paddock area. Service dogs must be on a lead.

13 EVENT CANCELLATION

The Organiser, in consultation with the Stewards of the Event(s), reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the Event or any part thereof for reasons of Force Majeure. Any entry fee refund will be made only at the discretion of the Organisers.
